

THE COOK CUP for Outstanding Restoration

THE COOK CUP recognizes the owner of a significant historic structure that has been transformed through a complete restoration adhering to the highest standards in method, materials and design. The nominee may be an individual, corporation or partnership, nonprofit organization, or government entity.

The judges consider:

- the importance of the structure,
- the condition of the structure at the outset,
- the magnitude and quality of the restoration, and
- the impact of the restored building on the community.

The restoration must have been completed within the past two years, and the structure must be in active use. (The landmark may be restored for its original use or adapted to a new purpose.)

The winner will receive an engraved silver cup on April 27, 2019 at Indiana Landmarks' annual Rescue Party in Indianapolis, with complimentary admission for two to the event, as well as recognition in *Indiana Preservation* magazine and in a release to media.

Background: Indiana Landmarks inaugurated THE COOK CUP for Outstanding Restoration in 2007 when the prize went to the award's namesake family in honor of their transformation of the West Baden and French Lick Springs hotels in southern Indiana.
