

Indianapolis City Market Catacombs Tours FAQ

Do you sell walk-up tickets?

A limited number of walk-up tickets MAY be available. However, to guarantee your spot and secure the best rate, we encourage you to purchase tickets in advance via Eventbrite or by calling Indiana Landmarks, 317-639-4534.

I can no longer attend the tour. Can I get a refund?

Refunds must be requested at least 7 days in advance of the scheduled tour. For tickets purchased on Eventbrite, only the face value of the tickets will be refunded, as Eventbrite no longer refunds purchasing fees.

Are the Catacombs visible from the street?

The Catacombs are located under City Market's Whistler Plaza. They are not visible from street level.

I want to go on the Catacombs tour, but I do not see a tour listed on the day I'm interested in.

We only offer Catacombs tours to the public on select days. If you are interested in booking a private tour for a specific date and time, we may be able to help. We require 3 weeks advance notice, and you must meet the 15-person (or \$225) minimum.

Can I see the Catacombs without going on the tour?

The Catacombs are private property. They may only be accessed via an Indiana Landmarks tour, during an event hosted in the space, or by other special permission granted by Indianapolis City Market.

I want to film, take photographs in, or host an event in the Catacombs. Who do I contact?

Indiana Landmarks does not manage the Catacombs space. For information about accessing the Catacombs for any purpose other than a tour, please contact Indianapolis City Market staff at 317-634-9266.

I am unable to navigate stairs. Can I go on the Catacombs tour?

The Catacombs space is only accessible via a staircase. If you'd like to explore other historic spaces in Indianapolis that are accessible to all, we encourage you to check out our Athenaeum or Monument Circle tours.

Are pets allowed on the tour?

Pets are not allowed on the tour, though trained service animals are welcome.

Do you talk about ghosts on this tour?

These tours focus on the history and preservation of the Catacombs space. If you are interested in tours featuring paranormal happenings, watch the Indianapolis City Market calendar for periodic paranormal investigation events held in the Catacombs.
